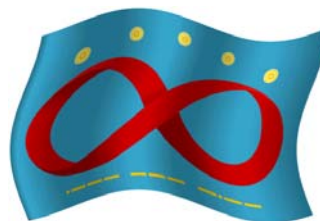


## CALL FOR PAPERS

### 4th ANNUAL COLLOQUIUM ON THE LAW OF FUTURISTIC PERSONS

**WHO:** Attorneys and other legal or policy professionals.

**WHAT:** The Colloquium will be an exchange of scholarly views regarding the appropriate legal treatment of futuristic persons known as a "transbemens.". Transbemens are beings that express a desire for human rights but are not currently considered legal persons. Examples of transbemens include computer systems that claim to be conscious, individuals who have been revived from post-mortem cryonic biostasis, and nano-biotech bodies with minds that have been downloaded from humans.

The term "transbeman" arises from the transitional nature of futuristic beings who will likely desire human legal standing.

**WHERE:** Terasem Space Coast Center, Melbourne Beach, Florida, approximately one hour east of Orlando and one hour south of Cape Canaveral.

**WHEN:** International Human Rights Day, December 10, 2008

**WHY:** To develop an optimal body of futuristic person law in advance of the immediate need for such law when scientists and entrepreneurs present society with transbeman persons.

**HOW:** Submit a title and 100-word abstract for a 20 minute PowerPoint presentation to [lori@terasemcentral.org](mailto:lori@terasemcentral.org) no later than July 10, 2008. Accepted presenters will be notified by August 20, 2008. Each presenter will be provided with 20 minutes to make their PowerPoint presentation to the Colloquium attendees, all of whom are also presenters, as well as to the general public via webcasting.

In between each presentation a further 20 minute period is provided for discussion. All presentations and discussions will be transcribed by a court reporter, the transcript of which will be submitted to each presenter for their approval. Once a presenter approves his or her transcript, it will be posted on the Colloquium website and may also be published in the Online Journal of Personal Cyberconsciousness.
